

Giving Directions

Giving directions in English is easy. All you have to remember is to use **LANDMARKS**. For example :

Go past MacDonalds and turn left (MacDonalds is the "Landmark")

Here are a few more examples:

A - Excuse me can you tell me where the bathroom is?

B - Yes. Go past reception and turn left. The bathroom is on your left.

A - Excuse me, can you tell me where the nearest bank is?

B - Of course. Go down the street to the next interchange. Turn left and go straight on for about 50 meters. Then go past Starbucks Coffee and the bank is across the street on your right hand side.

A - Excuse me, do you know where the Korean restaurant is?

B - Yes, go round the corner and go straight on until you reach the Hyundai Car shop. Then turn left and then first right. The Korean restaurant is on the left across the street.
